Results of Rua Bioscience Limited's 2021 Annual Shareholders' Meeting

At Rua Bioscience Limited's hybrid Rua Bioscience Annual Shareholders' Meeting (held online and in Gisborne yesterday) shareholders were asked to vote on two ordinary resolutions, which were supported by the Board.
